# Maria's Testimony of God's Transformation

Maria Auxiliadora is a 46 year old former prostitute living in the village of El Limonal, Nicaragua. For much of her life, Maria was steeped in the vicious cycle prostitution. Even more heart-breaking is the fact that Maria's daughters followed here into this lifestyle.

Until recently, Maria lived in a run down home built next to a permanently polluted water source, which she was forced to use for her daily necessities. Her life was filled with a constant threat of violence from neighbors, and Maria was consistently reluctant to participate in any positive forms of community activities.

A committed CHE Women's

Trainer named Fatima began to visit Maria on a regular basis along with other CHE workers from the local church, Iglesia Apostolica. Despite their efforts, Maria continually refused to welcome Fatima and the other CHE workers into her home. But Fatima and the CHE workers continued to pray for Maria and continued in their attempts to visit her. They never gave up praying that Maria's life would be touched and transformed by God.

The CHE workers from Iglesia Apostolica continued to witness to Maria, and finally Maria received Christ into her heart! Praise the Lord for His goodness in Maria's salvation!

Today, Maria's life has been truly transformed by God. She is no longer involved in prostitution. The stagnant, polluted water source near her home has been eliminated, and she is an active member in the local CHE Women's Group. She has since married a wonderful godly man, Henry Sanchez, and together they are living a life full of the joy of the Lord. This is truly a story of God's redemptive power in the lives of His Children!

However, Maria still faces a huge challenge that she constantly brings before the Throne of God: to help her daughters come to Christ and be delivered from the prison of prostitution.

But Gilberto’s life is a testimony to the strength of the healing power of God. In a recent conversation with CHE workers, Gilberto talked about how God’s blessings have continued to strengthen and encourage him.

“With Christ in my life, I have the strength and means to take care of my children”,

Gilberto testified. “I also have the ability to visit my neighbors and share with them all that Christ has done for me through the ministry of Community Health Evangelism”.

Gilberto lives in the village of Monte Cristo, Guatemala, which is situated among the Pacific coastal plains of north-western Guatemala. Florentin and Abel, the CHE trainers in charge of the village of Monte Cristo, ask that you keep praying for the wonderful work the Lord is doing

through Gilberto among the people of his village.

## CHE Training of Trainers Workshop

April 19-23, 2010, saw session 1 of the CHE Training of Trainers seminar (TOT1) take place with 27 participants from the Asociacion Misionera Bautista in the city of Quetzaltenango, Guatemala.

As part of their training, the participants were taken to the nearby village of Cantel to observe the methods of CHE in action and to witness the Gospel of Christ to many of the residents of Cantel. Through their witnessing efforts using the CHE Evangelism Booklet, the CHE training session participants saw several of the village residents come to Christ. Praise God for his faith-

fulness and goodness in saving the lost! Please pray for these new believers as they are followed up on by members of the local church.

Also, please continue to pray for the participants of TOT1 as they will now be implementing Phase One of CHE into at least five more villages and neighborhoods in their home regions. After Phase One is completed, these CHE workers will return to Quetzaltenango for their next round of leadership training (TOT2) in August.
