Five years ago, my wife and I were challenged to move to Hincesti city to be missionaries there. We had many fears, but we knew for sure that this is God's will for our lives at that moment. We decided to listen to His calling, so in May 2006 we moved to Hincesti. Everything was a total unknown for us. We had dreams and wishes for that little town, but we didn't know how to start the ministry. After a short period of time we found different methods of sharing the Gospel with people from that town. We worked a lot but the results were not those which we expected. After 2 years of hard work in that town, we did a short review and we were disappointed. A large number of our disciples left the town and other didn't want to follow Jesus any more. We had to start from the beginning. We were deeply disappointed but we thought that One who called us in this town cannot error. So we continued to work faithfully and God blessed us with 20 devoted disciples. This people grew up spiritually very fast and took our responsibilities in their hands. It was such a pleasure to see how our disciples were sharing the Good News with their colleagues, friends and even with unknown people. Within a year the ministry has grown incredibly. God helped us open a youth weekly club and few groups of Bible study. Many disciples have been baptized and joined the local church. But the greatest event that encouraged us and gave us the assurance that our work wasn't in vain, happened this spring.

Now after 5 years, the time has come to do some changes in our activity. We now have the challenge to move to Chisinau -the capital of Moldova Republic, and together with a group of Campus Crusade staff, to plant a new church. This is something new for me and my wife, but we

are sure that this is God's calling for us know. That doesn't mean that the ministry from Hincesti will stop. Because the Lord has blessed us with faithful disciples, they will continue do the ministry there, but we'll always be ready to help them.

The opening of the new church from Chisinau will be on September, 25. At the beginning, we will have around 50 or 70 members; many of these persons are people who came to Christ though Campus Crusade. We believe that God will use us in reaching people for His Kingdom.
