A few weeks ago, I had the privilege of traveling to Brazil to participate in our OC Global Alliance Worldwide Leadership Conference. The conference brought together about 140 OC leaders from around the world. It was thrilling for me as OC president to hear the reports from our field leaders about the strategic impact our teams of OC missionaries are having in nations around the world.



Throughout 2011, OC's more than 675 ministry personnel had the privilege of serving over 1 million national church leaders in more than 100 countries of the world! Through the ministries of these leaders, hundreds of thousands of churches have been equipped for more effective outreach in their communities, countries, and continents. As result, this past year tens of thousands of people have come to Christ and thousands of new churches have been planted.

For many of our missionaries, their ministries this past year have been carried out in the context of greatly increased financial pressures due to the continued impact of the worldwide economic downturn. As we come to the end of 2011, more than a third of our missionaries are behind in their financial support needs!
